Unlike many plywoods, LION Floor™ is an engineered product, that can give cast iron assurances that it will not contain any core gaps, and as an engineered board, it is impossible to have an 'veneer overlaps' or filler, which is common in many plywoods, thus guaranteeing a homogenous board.

Manufacturers of LVT, adhesives and all other allied products have welcomed this addition to the BS 8203 standard, as it now ensures their products are used alongside fabricated underlays that are approved and fit for purpose.
